DOUBLING YOUR TAX BENEFIT?Buck Griffith

Now that I'm a legitimate Senior Citizen (approaching my 80th birthday), I am privileged to spend increased amounts of time in physicians' offices. While there, I'm entertained by the jokes and "Laughing Matters" section of Seniorific News plus, updates on subjects of interest to seasoned citizens. In the January (2023) edition, I saw an article by Liz Weston (Nerd Wallet) about making the most of new rules concerning charitable giving. In the piece, she quotes Mark Astrinos (CPA and personal financial specialist in the San Francisco Bay area). Liz commented on how stock bought at a low price but may escalate with you can owing a big tax bill when sold. By donating that stock to a qualified charity like Family Upreach, you may avoid the tax bill. If you itemize deductions, you may be able to count the current price at the time of donation.

Astrinos illustrates this with one who invested \$10,000 in shares that are worth \$100,000 today. Selling it would mean \$90,000 in capital gains but donating it would create a \$100,000 deduction and bypass capital gains tax! "It's a double tax benefit," Astrinos says. It is worthy of strong consideration.

With such contributions, one of our most treasured efforts (the the "Little Angels" program) flourishes. This ministry works with those in and alcoholics/addicts to not only help them but spouses and children. We choose to call children "Little Angels" since they are 100% innocent

A SAMPLING OF THE VETNET PROGRAM

The **VetNet** program is awesome! We wish you could read all the comments in letters from students. Veterans have an appreciation and respect that all of us would do well to emulate despite their ongoing challenges. The following is one sample that is on my desk and mind today . . .

"I'm a Marine veteran. I saw action in Somalia where I lost several friends. I suffer from PTSD but not getting help for it. I do my best to forget and use alcohol and drugs. I realize it's not the best medicine, but it does ease the pain a little. I tried killing myself a couple of times, but someone always stops me. I have a shotgun shell with the firing pin marking on it — was it a dud or was God giving me a message? I found a group of veterans and we look out for each other. Together, we fight our demons. This is where YOU may be able to help. I was given a brochure about <u>VetNet</u>. Can you supply lessons for us to study together — one vet helping another vet?"

MORE ABOUT THE "GIDEON" PROJECT

We are concerned about having a sufficient number of qualified Christians to carry this ministry forward. Those with the greatest passion have "been there - done that." We are looking closely at ex-offenders that have risen to the top. We want to locate them and literally bring them here for a minimum of six months training. With our help, they will find employment, housing, transportation, etc., and as part of an *internship*, they will learn about every aspect of this ministry through personal involvement. From here, they may fill volunteer roles in local ministries throughout the nation and some will become part-time or full-time workers.



The label "Gideon" has been selected from Judges 7 because of the process God used to dwindle the original number of soldiers (32,000) down to the final 300. These chosen "few" were watchful, careful, and courageous. **God** is the true power behind the fall of Jericho's walls. We are hunting for the proverbial "needle in the haystack" - the *cream of the crop*. We seek help with recommendations and referrals from ministry workers everywhere. Some may have completed programs such as TPOM (Nashville), Project Rescue (Alabama), House for New Life (Nebraska), The Men of Nehemiah (Texas), Off the Chains (Florida), David & Jamie Green (Louisiana), Henry Petree (Oklahoma), etc.

In time, we believe that the "watchful, careful, and courageous" will change the landscape of prison ministry as we know it today. God will cause *the walls to fall down* in the hearts of disbelievers of this work's value. It is hard to look a converted "Saul of Tarsus" in the face and call this *a waste of time*, *energy*, *and money*.
