
JUNE 7-9: NATIONAL PRISON WORKSHOP

New Orleans is the place to be June 7-9. Don't miss it! Exciting things always happen (and a lot of it takes place outside the classrooms). This is not to suggest the topics or speakers won't be stimulating, but the bonus is being with fellow workers from *everywhere*. In the halls, display booths, breaks, meals, early mornings, late nights, etc., we get to see folks one-on-one to ask questions and get answers or ideas to improve our ministries. There is power in *networking*. Many value this experience as worthy enough to take vacation-time or leave jobs to travel at their own expense just to be here.

Let's take time to explore our 2023 Workshop theme: "Fortified." In December 2021, *Keep It Real* ministry purchased a 48,000 square foot facility for aftercare use. There are beds for 63 men. A three-year DOJ/DOC grant meets the needs of 50%. The Church of Christ of Greater New Orleans meets there with 150+ in Bible study and worship with David preaching. Tours of the facility will be available during the workshop. You can see more up-to-date information on Facebook at David Green-Keep it Real. It is regarded as the most comprehensive transitional living and re-entry program in Louisiana. Beneath its name (Keep It Real) is the description of **The Fort**. This will give you a "tip" about the meaning of "**Fortified**" for our workshop theme.

Soon after the early colonization of this *new* continent, people began expanding from the east coast to the west, north and south. A **fort** often preceded the building of communities, towns, cities, and states. Its mission was to be a refuge in time of danger and provide protection. Homes, churches, schools, and businesses would then be constructed. So, it is with this ministry. Those captured in Satan's traps are thrown into dark pits. Some come to the Light. Translated into the *spiritual* kingdom, these new citizens need help being **fortified** as they transition to their new lives where they will work, worship, and build new relationships prior to the final entry to *gloryland*.
